Second Announcement – Call for Abstracts

The *Red de Estudios sobre el Peronismo* calls for the submission of abstracts for its 6th *Conference on the Study of Peronism*. It will take place from 29 to 31 August 2018, at the Faculty of Economics, University of Buenos Aires. The Conference aims to provide a setting for fostering communication and critical reflections on current lines of research in order to stimulate tentative perspectives of knowledge related to Peronism, since its emergence until today.

Thematic panels will be organized once the abstracts and papers have been accepted according to these focal areas:

- **Politics**
- **Culture**
- **State and public policies**
- **Economy and society**
- **Comparative, regional and transnational studies**
- **Conceptual debates and methodological issues**

Abstract Submission Deadline: 7 March 2018 (abstract acceptance notification: 15 April)

Abstracts should be no more than 300 words, in a Word document, font Times New Roman size 12, and 1.5 line spacing. It should account for the analytical framework and key sources drawn on. Please use the heading “VI Congreso de Estudios sobre el Peronismo”, and include:

- **Focal Area**
- **Title**
- **Author’s name (maximum three authors)**
- **Institutional affiliation**
- **Email address**

Paper Submission Deadline: 31 May 2018 (paper acceptance notification: 30 June)

The heading, title, author’s name, institutional affiliation, and email address should be the same as those used in the abstract. All papers should be written in font Times New Roman, size 12, with 1.5 line spacing. Full papers must be no longer than 20 pages, including notes and citations. The papers will be evaluated by the corresponding area coordinators.
